- In order for your film to be accepted to Studentfilms.com, you must presently be a student or the film was made while you were a student. Exceptions are sometimes made for recent graduates. Please e-mail if there are any questions.
- Please make sure your tape has at least **one minute** of black and/or bars and tone before the start of your film so that your film doesn't start too early at the head of the tape.
- Please make sure your tape has **good audio**. If the levels are too low there will be a lot of tape hiss. Also make sure the reverse is true and it isn't clipping.
- If your film was edited on film, only **professional transfers** of the film to video are accepted. Steenbeck or "off the wall" transfers are not acceptable. Highest Quality in = Highest Quality out.
- One thing to watch out for: **Small text will be hard to read** on a computer screen. So if your film has a lot of small text such as subtitles they may be difficult to read on a computer screen. So make sure your titles are large enough for "the small screen".
- Your tapes will **NOT BE RETURNED**. I need to have them in case I need to redigitize the films. Please do not send me your only master of the film.
- Films that contain material that would be considered pornographic will not be accepted. Although films that would receive an "R" rating are fine.
- If there is anything you need clarification on or need to ask a question, please read the **Submission FAQ** on the site or e-mail me **before mailing** in your film.

Please read and sign:

- I have read and understand the above guidelines.
- I understand that the hosting fee is annual.⁸
- Studentfilms.com has the right to use stills from your film in order to promote the site. (Banner ads, etc)
- Studentfilms.com will add a ten second logo to the beginning of your film.
